

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FURZEHILL, COLEHILL

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Furzehill, Colehill from the junction with B3078 Cranborne Road to a point approximately 200 metres to the north east. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 09:30 to 15:30 on 10th November 2020 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11th November 2020.

**This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to replace two manholes in the highway.**

The alternative vehicular route, which will be sign posted is indicated by the blue line on the map below.
